The entries will be judged on presentation, tenderness, flavor, etc. Grills, charcoal, ground chuck (provided by Durand Meat Processing) and turn in boxes will be furnished. Participants provide their own spices, pre-prepared condiments (such as onions, pickles, etc.), buns (if desired) and cooking utensils. **No knives will be allowed on site.** Plan for three hamburgers.

**IMPORTANT:** Adult supervision is required, however, only the contestants are allowed to cook, prepare and handle their entries.
