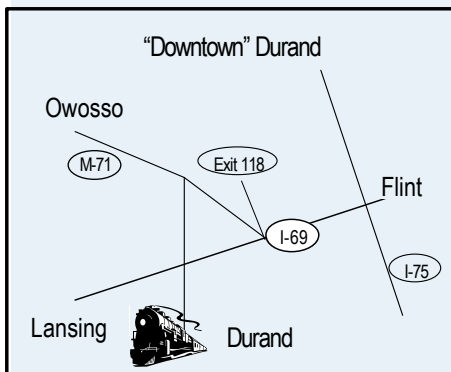


Directions

Coming from Flint, MI take I-69 West toward Lansing, take M-71, Exit 118, Durand/Corunna. Turn left on to M-71 (Lansing Rd.), turn right on Saginaw St. Railroad Days Carnival is on Main St. east of Saginaw St.

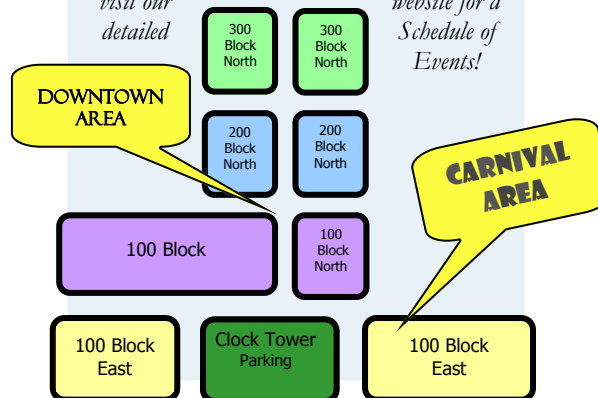

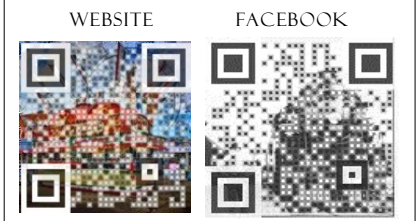

as "The Queen of the Rails"*

The Durand Union Station was built in 1903 and is said to be the most photographed depot in the United States. It was purchased by the City of Durand in 1979 for \$1.00 from Grand Trunk Western Railroad. In August of 1985, the restoration of the Depot was transferred to Durand Union Station, Inc. It is the home of the State Railroad History Museum, The Grand Trunk Historical Society, the Ann Arbor Railroad Technical & Historical Association and the Durand Union Station Model Railroad Engineers display.
